Conservation of slow lorises in Sumatra

Introduction

Greater slow loris
(Nycticebus coucang)
is a protected
prosimian species native
to the Indonesian island of Sumatra,
peninsular Malaysia,
Singapore and Thailand.





Slow lorises are at risk mainly because of illegal wildlife trafficking – owing to their cuteness they are being sold as pets.

The Kukang Rescue Program was founded in 2014 as a response to the critical situation of illegal trade in slow lorises in Sumatra. In 2017, the program established the Wildlife Preservation Foundation (PASAL Foundation) under which all activities in Indonesia have been run.

Our goals



Operation of a rescue and rehabilitation centre for slow lorises confiscated from the black market



Raising awareness about the illegal trade in animals and about protection of slow lorises



Cooperation with local government agencies on slow loris conservation and on wildlife protection law enforcement



Organizing community engagement activities



Setting up an Indonesian team that will implement most of the conservation activities

Establishment of Sumatra's first rescue centre specializing in slow lorises



Organization of awareness-raising events



Creating a Czech-Indonesian team

Our further plans

- Development of facilities of the rescue and rehabilitation centre
- Creation of a thorough rehabilitation and release protocol
- Preparation of a new release site for a pilot release of rehabilitated animals
- Support of capacity-building of local environmental agencies and training of our employees
- Promotion of environmental education of general public
- Creation of environmental clubs in villages located close to forests
- Support of local people's livelihoods by sustainable coffee production



Our rescue and rehabilitation centre specialized on slow lorises is the first of its kind in Sumatra. Thanks to that, slow lorises from black market can be confiscated, rehabilitated and eventually released back into the wild.

Together we can help protect slow lorises against the illegal trade and preserve these enigmatic animals for future generations.
